

Information on processing of personal data

1. Controller

The controller of personal data is SGH Warsaw School of Economics with its seat in Warsaw (Poland), al. Niepodległości 162, hereinafter referred to as SGH.

3. The purposes and legal basis of processing of personal data

Your personal data will be processed for the purposes of taking part in Knowledge Management 2024 Conference, of maintaining contact with you in connection with this conference and for the purpose of documenting the course of conference. The legal basis for processing of personal data is necessity for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest – point (e) of Art. 6 (1) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Official Journal of the European Union, L 119, 4 May 2016, p. 1 as amended) and The Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws [Dz.U.] of 2023 item 742 as amended).

4. The source and categories of the personal data

Personal data that you have provided in connection with registration via The International Institute for Applied Knowledge Management website (name, surname, affiliation, e-mail address) will be disclosed by this association.

5. The recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data

If the controller uses the services of other entities, personal data may be disclosed to them on the basis of contracts entrusting the processing of personal data, and these entities will be obliged to preserve the confidentiality of the data being processed.

6. The period for which the personal data will be processed

Your personal data will be processed for the duration of storing archival documentation.

7. The rights of data subject

You have the right to access and rectify your data, erase or restrict the processing thereof. You have the right to object to processing.

Your data will not undergo profiling and no automated decision-making will be conducted based on these data.

8. The right to lodge a complaint

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if you consider that the processing of your personal data infringes upon GDPR.
